The difference was even more pronounced when only the 72 infants with rotavirus were considered: 27% were cured with milk, compared with 68% with yogurt (G Boudraa, unpublished observations, 1996). Note that a significant shortening of gastroenteritis was reported in adults treated with heat-killed lactobacilli (Lacteol fort, Lactéol du Dr Boucard, France) (46). The protective effects of probiotics against intestinal infections were shown in animal models (23, 24, 47).
