Asterix and the Roman Agent is the fifteenth volume of the Asterix comic book series, The resistance of the Gaulish village against the Romans causes friction between dictator Julius Caesar and the Roman Senate, whose power had been reduced by Caesar. With their Magic Potion which gives them superhuman strength and is known only to their druid Getafix, they easily stand up against Rome and her laws. But Roman Agent, at number 15 was their inspired pinnacle. In many adventures the magic potio Goscinny and Uderzo, after an exploratory start, went through a purple patch with volumes 3 to 23 being among their best efforts.
